## Greetings from our Chairman

Dear All

Welcome to the first Commissioners Annual newsletter.

We are still receiving complaints from the public in relation to some dog owners not binning their dogs mess, and instead, throwing it into hedges. I know I have mentioned this in the past but it is worth repeating. To put it bluntly, this has got to stop! They are doing the unpleasant part by bagging the mess but not bothering to put the bags into the bins provided. To this effect we are taking action.

In addition to the above, since our last newsletter, we have had Tynwald approval of our Marown Dog Control Bye-law. This bye-law will impose controls on dogs in certain parts of the parish of Marown. Dogs will be prohibited from specified open spaces and must not be at large in specifically defined areas. Dog owners will also be responsible for ensuring the removal of dog faeces. Contravention of these bye-laws will be an offence by the keeper of the dog, punishable by a fixed penalty of £50 or, upon summary conviction, a fine of up to £1,000.

We have recently had final approval for the play area off Glen Vine Road. Please rest assured that work will commence on until traffic calming measures have been completed on Glen Vine Road.

Talking of road works, please be advised that works will be commencing on Monday 10th July to replace the traffic signals at the A1/Ballagarey Road junction, Glen Vine. Temporary traffic signals will be in operation throughout the duration. The duration of works will be approximately 4 weeks, this is to include resurfacing works of the carriageways at Ballagarey Road and the section of the A1 between the Ballagarey Road and Glen Darragh road junctions. This Project consists of the overlaying a section of road suffering from surface course failure leading to potholes and uneven surface which was a particular issue in this residential area. Overlaying this section of road will address these issues with the carriageway and will provide a smoother road surface giving improved ride quality.

For your information, please find enclosed a copy of the Commissioners submission to the planners regarding the Eastern Area Plan.

Finally, I look forward to seeing as many of you as possible at the Marown Parish Day on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2017.
